Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

The fourth event of the Project "us4EU" was held in Andrychow, Poland, from 13th to 16th March 2024. It gathered 78 participants, including representatives from 16 partner organizations across all Europe.

Activities:

It featured a program combining participatory activities with conferences and debates. Firstly, the "Role of Women in 21st Century Europe" addressed contemporary societal issues concerning gender equality, women's civic participation, and challenges and achievements in this domain. Secondly, discussions centered around the "Achievements of the European Union throughout its History," highlighting the EU's contributions to peace, prosperity, social cohesion, environmental protection, and global cooperation.

The program included sessions with distinguished speakers, panel discussions, workshops, and cultural visits to local landmarks funded by EU projects. Participants had the opportunity to engage in meaningful discussions, share experiences, and learn from each other's perspectives.

The event received extensive coverage on social media platforms, generating around 3800 thousand impressions, and attracted local media attention, including interviews and live coverage on Local Radio Andrychow.

Various activities were organized to facilitate engagement and learning. These included conferences and debates featuring experts and community leaders, presentations and panels showcasing success stories and relevant examples, guided tours of the host city and its projects funded by EU funds, and workshops and participatory activities encouraging collaboration and idea exchange among participants from diverse backgrounds.
